Melyd Surgical Ltd is committed to working towards achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

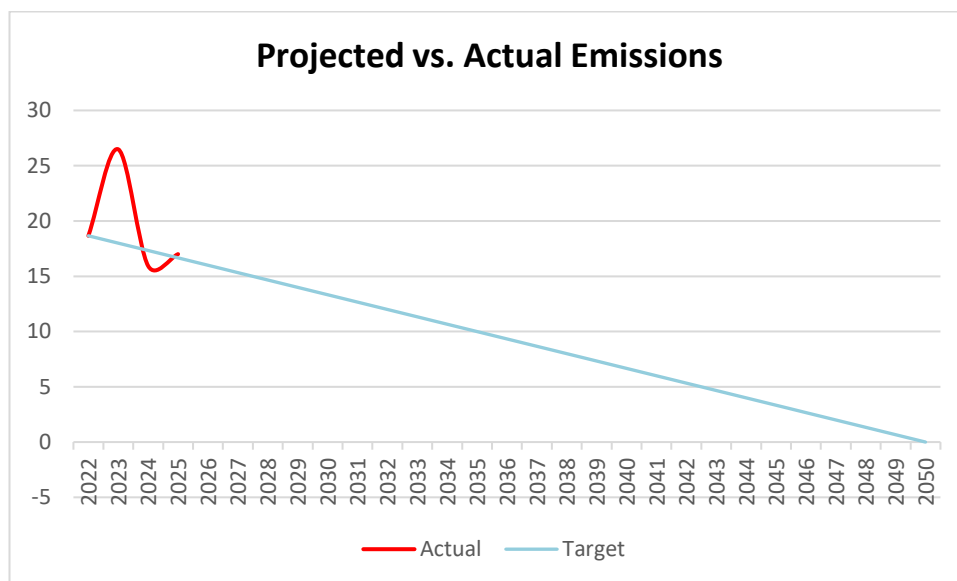
4 Emissions Reduction Target

The ultimate ambition is to drive emissions and to reach net zero emissions across our value chain by 2050. The focus of our efforts between now and then is to deliver absolute GHG reductions. We will seek out opportunities to reduce emissions and encourage carbon removals within our value chain.

We have a target for year-on-year reduction, with performance measured and acted upon.

Energy is now only procured from renewable energy source supplier effectively making associated Scope 2 emissions Net Zero.

5 Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since or before the 2022 baseline:

- We use 100% renewable energy since April 2024. Our premises are equipped with an air source heating system (no use of gas) and only heated when and as required and when staff on-site.
- We have an ultra-low emission vehicle fleet which is compliant with TFL standards.
- We do car share or cycle to work wherever possible.
- We retain and reuse working components from decommissioned medical devices where possible to ensure optimal use and longevity of the product.
- We separate our waste to minimise waste to landfill and we repair, reuse, refurbish or recycle wherever possible.
- We have reduced printing and paper use, and we will continue to minimize paper waste.

- We review our purchasing frequency and volumes to optimise shipping routes and lower CO₂ emissions.
- We make each road trip as economical and energy efficient as possible. We combine our service and repair runs with several customer visits in the same area. More and more we incorporate collections of damaged equipment from customer sites or returns of repaired equipment/delivery of customer orders, rather than using a courier when a customer site is en route.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- We continue to review a 'greener alternative' to our vehicle fleet.
- We continue to review opportunities to reduce waste across our operations through effective recycling, donations, reusage.
- We will give preference to carbon neutral transport providers.

6 Declaration and Sign off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
